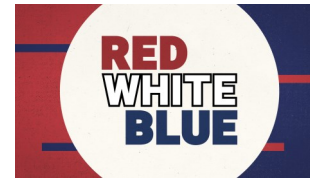
We need your help to reach out to people and invite them to church. On the office bulletin board are people in our community who have either been disconnected from our community or who for various reasons are not geographically close to attend church.
